Manuel Abendroth, Jérôme Decock e Els Vermang. O trio foi criado em 1996 e atualmente trabalha em Bruxelas, na Bélgica. LAb[au] cria principalmente obras de arte interativas, performances, audiovisuais e cenografia, para as quais desenvolvem seus próprios softwares e interfaces.

A arte experimental e inovadora do LAb[au] se concentra na pesquisa fundamental sobre influências dos ideais contemporâneos na arte, enquanto questiona os materiais, ferramentas e métodos atuais. Eles discutem também a estética contemporânea e semiótica, pelo pensamento conceitual e algorítmico, enquanto usam a geometria, cor, luz e movimento.

Suas obras fazem parte de coleções públicas e privadas pelo mundo.
